EASTERN EUROPE

DAY 1 - BUDAPEST



Arrive **Budapest International Airport** and continue to **Budapest city centre**. Overlook **Buda Castle**, **Fisherman Bastion / Matthias Church**. Visit **Hungarian Parliament Building** a famous landmark in Budapest that is located on the Pest side of the Danube River.

Spend time at the city centre.

DAY 2 - BRATISLAVA




Proceed to **Bratislava** and visit **Bratislava Castle** a historic building serving as a fortress, a royal residence, and a cultural center.

Continue to **Old Town** and spend time while visiting **St Martin Cathedral** a historic coronation church for the Kingdom of Hungary.

Continue journey and overnight in **Prague**





DAY 3 - PRAGUE



Proceed to **Prague Old town** and visit **Charles Bridge** a historic, medieval stone arch bridge in Prague, Czech Republic, that crosses the Vltava River.

Also visit **Prague Astronomical Clock** a 15th-century medieval clock on the Old Town Hall tower, famous for its astronomical dial and hourly show of the Procession of the Apostles.

Overnight in **Prague**



DAY 4 - SALZBURG

Long drive to **Old Town of Salzburg** and visit **Mirabell Garden** a famous Baroque garden known for its beautiful sculptures, geometric design, and role as a filming location for the movie *The Sound of Music*.

Continue to visit **Hohensalzburg Castle** a prominent, large medieval fortress and Mozarts Geburtshaus.

Overnight in **Salzburg**




DAY 5 - HALLSTATT

Proceed to **Hallstatt** a picturesque village in Austria or the late Bronze Age/early Iron Age culture named after it. The Austrian village is a UNESCO World Heritage Site nestled on the shore of Lake Hallstatt, known for its 16th-century alpine houses and historic salt mines.

Overnight in **Salzburg**





DAY 6 - VIENNA



Proceed to **Vienna** and visit **Hofburg Complex** a vast palace complex in Vienna, Austria, that was the former winter residence and seat of power for the Habsburg dynasty for over 600 years.

Proceed to **Schönbrunn Palace** a former imperial summer residence of the Habsburg rulers now a major tourist attraction and a UNESCO World Heritage site. The palace is a magnificent example of Baroque architecture, featuring 1,441 rooms and sprawling gardens that contain attractions like the Neptune Fountain and the Gloriette.

Overnight in **Vienna**



DAY 7 - PANDORF

Proceed to **Pandorf Designer Outlet** and spend time at a large designer outlet shopping center located that features over 160 international brands.

Proceed **Vienna International Airport** for journey back home
