DAY 1 - MUNICH

DAY 2 - SALZBURG




Proceed to **BMW Welt** a futuristic architecture with exhibitions of current and future BMW vehicles and a lifestyle store.

Continue to **Salzburg** a city in Austria known for its rich history, culture, and stunning Alpine setting. The city's historic Old Town is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, renowned for its well-preserved Baroque architecture and cultural significance.

DAY 3 - HALLSTAT



Visit **Hallstatt** a picturesque lakeside village in Austria, renowned for its stunning Alpine scenery and rich history, making it a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Historically significant due to its ancient salt mines, the village is known for its 16th-century alpine houses and is situated on Lake Hallstatt's western shore

DAY 4 - NEUSCHWANSTEIN CASTLE

Visit **Neuschwanstein Castle** a 19th-century Romanesque-style fairytale castle commissioned by King Ludwig II of Bavaria in Germany, intended as a personal refuge and a homage to the Middle Ages.

Overnight in **Lustenau**




DAY 5 - RHEINFALLS - BERN

Proceed to **Rheinfalls**, Europe's largest and most powerful waterfall in Schaffhausen.

Continue to **Bern**, the capital city of Switzerland and visit the old city of Bern which preserve medieval architecture dated back to the 12th century.

Overnight in **Bern / Interlaken**





DAY 6 - BLAUSEE - INTERLAKEN - LAUTERBRUNNEN



Visit **Lake Blausee**, a picturesque and small lake in Switzerland, famous for its crystal-clear, blue-turquoise waters. Located in the Bernese Oberland near Kandergrund.

Proceed to **Interlaken West**, a town in central Interlaken.

End the day to visit **Lauterbrunnen** which is known for its stunning "valley of 72 waterfalls" with dramatic cliffs, famous falls like Staubbach. Experience cable car and train ride to Murren and enjoy stunning views of the Eiger, Mönch, and Jungfrau mountains.

Overnight in **Thun/Interlaken**




DAY 7 - MT TITLIS - LUCERNE

Proceed to Engelberg to visit the famous **Mt Titlis**. Experience the world's first revolving aerial cable car, which transports passengers from the middle station to the summit of Mt. Titlis in Switzerland.

Continue journey to **Lucerne**, a city in central Switzerland known for its well-preserved medieval architecture, picturesque setting on Lake Lucerne, and proximity to the Alps.

Overnight in **Lucerne / Zurich**





DAY 8 - ZURICH



Proceed to **Lind Home of Chocolate** and view the a giant chocolate fountain. Visit the chocolate shop and cafe'

Continue journey to **Zurich City Centre** a historic Old Town (Altstadt), a walkable area stretching from the Central square to Bürkliplatz and encompassing both sides of the **Limmat Riverand** also visit **Lake Zurich**.

Proceed to **Zurich International Airport** for journey back home.
