

Travel ITINERARY

AURORA ICELAND

DAY 1 - STROKKUR GEYSIR - GULLFOSS WATERFALL



Arrive at **Keflavik International Airport** and proceed to to visit **Strokkur Geysir** an Iceland's most active and famous geyser, and **Gullfoss Waterfall** a famous two-tiered waterfall in southwest Iceland, known as the "**Golden Waterfall**," where the Hvítá river cascades into a deep canyon and visit.

Continues to **Seljalandsfoss Waterfall** a 60 metre tall high waterfall and is fed by the Seljalandsá River, which flows from the Eyjafjallajökull glacier

Overnight in **Skogar**




DAY 2 - SOLHEIMANSANDUR - SKOGAR WATERFALL

Proceed to **Solheimansandur (Plane Wreck)** the remains of a U.S. Navy Douglas DC-3 (officially a C-117) aircraft that crash-landed on the black sand beach. It is famous for its appearance in commercials, music videos (including Justin Bieber's "I'll Show You"), and the Indian film Dilwale.

Continue journey to **Skogar Waterfall** a massive and popular waterfall in southern Iceland, known for its impressive 60-meter drop, width of 25 meters, and beautiful, often-rainbow-filled mist.





DAY 2 - CONTINUED



Proceed to **Blacksand Beach** a world-famous black sand beach in Iceland, known for its dramatic volcanic landscape including basalt columns, sea caves, and the sea stacks

Overnight in **Skogar**



DAY 3 - EGILSSTADIR - DIAMOND BEACH

Long drive journey to **Egilsstadir** and visit Jökursárlón Iceberg a glacial lagoon in Iceland, not a single Iceberg. It formed as the Breiðamerkurjökull glacier (an outlet of the larger Vatnajökull glacier) retreated, and is now filled with icebergs that have broken off from the glacier.


Enjoy the **Ice Cave Tour** an excursion from Iceland's Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon that takes participants into a natural ice cave on the nearby **Vatnajökull glacier**.



Proceed to **Diamond Beach** a black sand beach in Iceland where large and small icebergs from the nearby Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon wash ashore. The "diamonds" are chunks of ancient glacier ice that have broken off and floated through the lagoon to the ocean, before being tossed back by the waves, creating a stunning contrast against the dark volcanic sand

Overnight in **Skogar**





DAY 4 - SELFOSS WATERFALL - REYJAVIK



Proceed to **Selfoss waterfall** a wide, powerful waterfall in **North Iceland** located on the Jökulsá á Fjöllum river, just a few hundred meters upstream from Dettifoss.

Continue to **Reyjavik** and enjoy Whale Watching a tour activity that takes place from **Reykjavik's old harbor**, offering boat trips to spot various marine life like minke whales, humpback whales, dolphins, and porpoises in the surrounding Faxaflói Bay.

Then visit **Hallgrímskirkja** church a prominent and iconic Evangelical-Lutheran church, Sun Voyager Sculpture a stainless steel sculpture by Icelandic artist **Jón Gunnar Árnason** and spend sometime at Rainbow Street.

At night you will head to Blue Lagoon a famous geothermal spa in Iceland, known for its mineral-rich, milky-blue waters that are naturally heated

Overnight in Reyjavik.



DAY 5 - KEFLAVIK

Transfer to **Keflavik International Airport** for journey back home.
