SOUTH NEW ZEALAND

DAY 1 - BOTANIC GARDENS- RIVERSIDE MARKET



Arrive **Christchurch International Airport** and proceed to **Botanic Gardens** a large, historic park in the city's center that features diverse plant collections, gardens, and conservatories.

Continue to **Riverside Market** a vibrant, indoor, 7-day-a-week market in the heart of the city's CBD, offering a wide range of local produce, specialty foods, and international cuisine.

Proceed to **Akaroa** a historic harbor town on the Banks Peninsula in New Zealand.

Overnight in **Christchurch**




DAY 2 - LAKE TEKAPO

Proceed to **Lake Tekapo** via Canterbury Plains. Visit The **Church of the Good Shepherd** is a small, historic Anglican church built in 1935 on the shores of Lake Tekapo and Mt. John Observatory a New Zealand's largest professional research observatory, located on Mt. John overlooking Lake Tekapo

Overnight in **Tekapo**. Stargazing at night if weather is clear





DAY 3 - LAKE PUKAKI



Journey along **Lake Pukaki** and stop at High Country **Salmon Farm** (Lake Pukaki) a popular salmon farm known for its fresh salmon products and tourist-friendly amenities.



Continue journey to **Hooker Valley Track** and proceed to **Lake Müller** Lookout a viewpoint that provides stunning panoramic views of the glacier-fed Lake Müller, the Mueller Glacier, and the surrounding Southern Alps.

Overnight in **Mount Cook**

DAY 4- CROMWELL - ARROWTOWN




Proceed by **Cromwell** a city of fruit-growing industry, especially stone fruits and berries, earning it the nickname "fruit bowl of the south"

Continue to **Arrowtown** a historic gold mining town famous for its well-preserved heritage, natural beauty, and connection to the 1860s gold rush.

Overnight in **Queenstown**





DAY 5 - TE ANAU



Long drive to **Te Anau** and experience **Milford Sound cruise** a spectacular glacier-carved fjord in New Zealand's **Fiordland National Park**, famous for its stunning scenery including sheer cliffs, waterfalls, and the iconic Mitre Peak.

Overnight in Queenstown

DAY 6 - GLENORCHY



Scenic drive to **Glenorchy** a small town at the northern end of **Lake Wakatipu** known for its stunning scenery, hiking, and as a filming location for movies like The Lord of the Rings.

Continue Journey back to **Queenstown** and spend time at **Queenstown city**.

Proceed **Queenstown International Airport** for journey back home
