

Travel ITINERARY

UK SCOTLAND WALES

DAY 1 - CAMBRIDGE CITY



Arrived London Heathrow Airport and proceed to **Cambridge city** an historic city in England known for its world-renowned university.

Visit **King's College** a constituent college of the University of Cambridge, founded in 1441 by King Henry VI.

Then visit **Cambridge Market Square** a historic public square in the city's center that has been a hub of activity since the Middle Ages, featuring a daily market with a wide variety of goods from food to crafts, surrounded by shops and historic buildings.

Overnight in **Northampton**




DAY 2 - OXFORD CITY

Proceed to **Oxford City** a county town of Oxfordshire, England, and is a historic cathedral city famous for being home to the world-renowned University of Oxford.

Visit **Bodleian Library** the main research library for the **University of Oxford** and **Radcliffe Camera** a historic circular library building at the University of Oxford, known for its iconic domed rotunda and Baroque architecture.





DAY 2 - CONTINUED



Continue journey to **Stow on the Wold** a historic market town in **Gloucestershire, England**, known for its location on an 800-foot hill in the **Cotswolds**, its market square, and its medieval history, which includes being a hub for the wool trade.

Overnight in **Swindon**

DAY 3 - BATH



Proceed to **Bath** a historic city in Somerset, England, famous for its Roman-built baths and elegant Georgian architecture.


Visit Roman Bath a historic Roman bathing and religious complex built around natural hot springs in the city of Bath, Bath Abbey a historic Anglican parish church in Bath, UK, known for its fan-vaulted ceiling and impressive architecture and **Pulteney Weir by River Avon** a historic landmark on the River Avon in Bath, England, located just downstream from the iconic **Pulteney Bridge**.

Continue to **Cardiff** the capital and largest city of Wales and visit Cardiff Castle a historic medieval fortress in Cardiff, Wales, with a 2,000-year history that includes Roman and Norman origins and a famous Victorian transformation.

Also visit **Principality Stadium** that serves as the home of the Welsh national rugby team and **Cardiff Bay** a freshwater lake and waterfront area

Overnight in **Cardiff**.





DAY 4 - BIRMINGHAM - LIVERPOOL



Proceed to **Birmingham** and visit the world's largest **Primark at Bullring Shopping Centre**.

Continue to **Liverpool** and visit **Anfield Stadium** the home stadium for Liverpool Football Club.

Continue to **Liverpool Waterfront** and visit **Beetle's Monument, Liverpool Cathedral a large, Gothic Revival Anglican cathedral, St. George's Hall a Grade I listed neoclassical landmark** opposite Lime Street Station that originally housed law courts and a concert room and visit Liverpool Library the largest of the city's libraries.

Overnight in **Liverpool**



DAY 5 - MANCHESTER - YORK


Proceed to **Manchester** and visit the **Old Trafford Stadium** the home stadium for Manchester United Football Club

Continue to **York** a historic walled city in **North Yorkshire, England**, founded by the Romans and later a Viking capital. Here we will visit Shambles Market a historic meat market street, originating from the medieval period.

End the day with shopping at **York Designer Outlet** a large shopping destination that features over 100 designer and high-street brands with year-round discounts.

Overnight in **York**





DAY 6 - SCOTLAND - GLASGOW



Long drive to Scotland and head to **Glasgow** which is known for its Victorian and Art Nouveau architecture, and as a major cultural hub with a strong industrial past.

Here will visit **Glasgow University**, a public state-supported university in Scotland, founded in 1451, making it the fourth-oldest university in the English-speaking world, **Glasgow Botanic Garden** a public garden in the West End of Glasgow, located by the River Kelvin, that features both indoor and outdoor plant collections for scientific research, education, and public enjoyment and spend some time at **George Square**.

Overnight in **Glasgow**



DAY 7 - LOCH NESS

Long journey to **Loch Ness** a large freshwater loch in the Scottish Highlands famous for the legend of the Loch Ness Monster.

Overnight in **Glasgow**

DAY 8 - EDINBURGH

Proceed to **Swanston Farm** a beautiful rural setting with views of the hills and city, and it is home to a herd of Highland cows.

Continue to to **Royal Mile** a historic street in **Edinburgh, Scotland**, that runs through the **Old Town** and connects **Edinburgh Castle** with the Palace of Holyroodhouse.

Proceed to **Edinburgh International Airport** for journey back home.
